SESSION 2022-23

The Road Safety Club plays a crucial role in promoting road safety awareness and education in local communities. With a mission to reduce the number of accidents and fatalities on the roads, the club organizes various events on the importance of safe road practices. Through its programs, the club also aims to raise awareness about the consequences of reckless driving and the need for stricter road safety regulations. The Road Safety Club is committed to promoting safe and responsible driving practices and reducing the number of road accidents. Over the past year, we have continued to work to achieve this goal. Road Safety Club has also been working to raise awareness about the importance of following traffic rules and regulations.

During the session 2022-23, enrolment as a volunteer started in the month of August 2022, and Road Safety Club received 62 applications from various courses. To achieve the above stated goal, classes were undertaken, organised awareness rally, a guest lecture on the "Importance of Insurance" was given by officials, and various competitions were organised such as essay writing, slogan writing, and poster making. Distribution of printed materials such as Road Safety Diaries was also undertaken. Road Safety Calendars are hung on the walls of College/Classes are held to raise awareness about road safety precautions, traffic rules, drunken driving, and using mobile phones while driving.

ACTIVITIES

INDUCTION PROGRAMME

On 10th September 2022, an induction programme was organized by the Road Safety Club (RSC). The inauguration was conducted by Mrs. Neeru Thakur, Principal and Mr. Nishant Narang, RSC coordinator, and it was attended by the Road Safety volunteers who had enrolled to be a part of the club. The induction programme aimed to educate and inform the volunteers about the importance of road safety and to discuss the objectives of the club.

The Road Safety Club is an initiative to create awareness about road safety and educate students about the rules and regulations that need to be followed while on the road. The club aims to create responsible citizens who are aware of their surroundings and take the necessary steps to ensure their safety and the safety of others. ROAD SAFETY AWARENESS CLASSES




























SELFIE MOMENT

A GUEST LECTURE ON "IMPORTANCE OF INSURANCE"

On 12th December 2022, a guest lecture was organized on the Importance of Insurance by Mr. Pamil Jariyal, an insurance expert. The lecture was specifically focused on the types of insurance that can be beneficial for road safety. The lecture was attended by around 50 students and faculty members of the college.

The lecture started with an introduction to insurance and its importance in our daily lives. Mr. Jariyal explained how insurance is a safety net that helps individuals and organizations to mitigate the financial risks that may arise due to unforeseen events. He emphasized the fact that insurance is not an expense but an investment that provides financial protection in the long run. Mr. Jariyal further elaborated on the importance of third-party liability insurance, which covers damages caused to third-party vehicles or individuals due to the insured's negligence. He also highlighted the fact that it is mandatory for all vehicle owners to have third-party liability insurance as per the Motor Vehicles Act. The lecture concluded with a question and answer session, where the audience had the opportunity to ask questions and clarify their doubts. Mr. Jariyal answered all the questions patiently and provided valuable insights on insurance and road safety.

It highlighted the significance of insurance in our daily lives and its importance in the context of road safety.
