
Brief Summary of the Activity



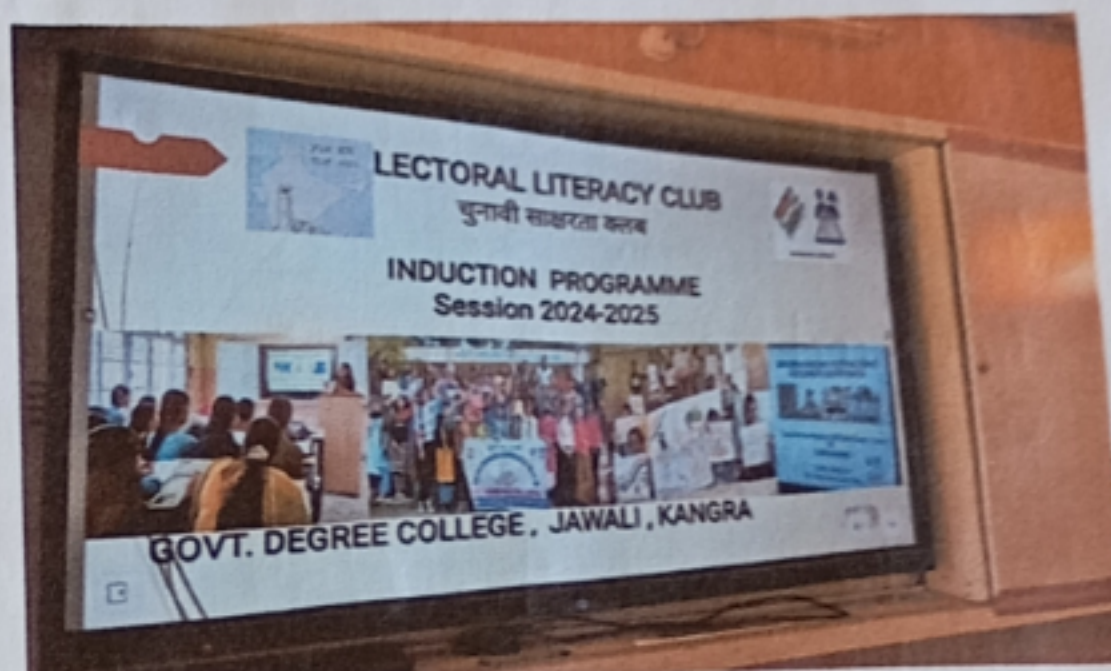


The session began with an introduction by the ELC coordinator, who highlighted the significance of understanding the concept of simultaneous elections and its potential impact on India's democratic process.


