Because the majority of road traffic accidents are caused by the younger generation, road traffic accidents are a global issue that must be addressed. The death toll is higher in countries where pedestrians, bicyclists, and passengers are at risk and when traffic signal ethics are lacking. The goal of the Road Safety Club is to raise awareness among college students about traffic accidents, traffic rules, and dos and don'ts. To achieve the above stated goal, various competitions such as essay writing, slogan writing, poster making, and quiz; guest lecture; and distribution of printed materials such as Road Safety Diaries, Road Safety Calendars, and Banners of Road Safety Signs are hung on the walls of College/Classes are held to raise awareness about road safety precautions, traffic rules, drunken driving, and using mobile phones while driving are held.

ACTIVITIES

On September 24, 2021, a road safety awareness programme was held in the College Campus for volunteers to inform them about the road safety club, the objective for which it was formed, the activities that would be carried out, and the road safety signs. Mrs. Neeru Thakur, the principal, stated that this awareness campaign should not be confined to volunteers and that similar programmes should be held on a regular basis to raise student knowledge about road safety. Students should adhere to traffic laws and encourage their friends and relatives to do so as well. On this occasion, Dr. Madhu Bala was present, as was Road Safety Club nodal officer Nishant Narang.



On December 20, 2022, a road safety pledge was organised for students, staff, and members of the road safety club, and the pledge was administered by Volunteer Shruti. The pledge was taken by around 250 students, 5 faculty members, and 3 non-teaching staff members. Following the pledge, volunteers organised a rally on road safety from the college campus to Kheria Chowk, to inform the general public about traffic safety. Prior to the start of the rally, Mrs. Neeru Thakur, the Principal, addressed the students about road safety guidelines. Mr. Ashwani Kumar, Mr. Sulakshan Kumar, and Mrs. Sonika were among those who attended the rally. The youngsters took part in the event with zeal and raised awareness about road safety.



An awareness campaign for students in the Computer Lab was held on February 10, 2022. Students were shown a number of road safety awareness and instructional videos, as well as details on the MoRTH website.



The Importance of Road Safety, Challenges in Maintaining Road Safety in India, and Role of Youth in Road Safety were the topics of an essay writing competition held on February 17, 2022. The competition got in a total of 18 students. Nancy from B.A. 3rd year got the 1st Position, Priya Koundal from B.Com 1st year received the 2nd Position, Priya from B.A. 3rd year and Ritika Choudhary from B.A. 1st year received the 3rd Position.

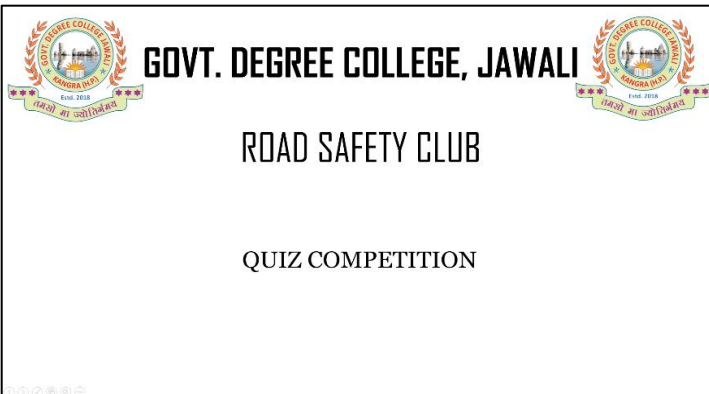


A Slogan Writing and Poster Making Competition on Road Safety was held on February 21, 2022. The event attracted a total of 31 students. In the poster making competition, Aditi came in first, Anmol Guleria came in second, and Sejal came in third. In the Slogan Writing Competition, Kajal won first place, followed by Prarthna and Apeksha Gupta in second place, and Priyanka in third place.





On February 24, 2022, a Quiz Competition was organized to increase the awareness of students on traffic norms. The Principal, Mrs. Neeru Thakur inaugurated the competition which saw participation of about 25 students from 5 teams. Team C bagged the first prize in the quiz, which was based on traffic rules and road safety. The competition consisted of three rounds. Post the quiz competition an Awareness rally was organized.



On the 26th of February, 2022, a guest lecture on road safety and a prize distribution ceremony were held. Mr. Ashwani Kumar, Head of the English Department, addressed the students and stated that road safety knowledge is critical in preventing road accidents. Students, particularly those in higher education institutions, disregard traffic restrictions, speed excessively, and drive defective automobiles, resulting in death and serious injury. Students were informed about traffic guidelines.

The Principal, Mrs. Neeru Thakur, and Mr. Ashwani Sharma presented prizes and certificates to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in various events such as Essay Writing, Slogan Writing, Poster Making, and Quiz Competition. With the national anthem, the programme came to a successful conclusion. Mr. Sulakshan Kumar, Mr. Neeraj Kumar, Mrs. Sonika and Dr. Madhu Bala, and Mr. Rajneesh Chand were all present at the event.

निबंध लेखन में नैसी ने जमाई धाक

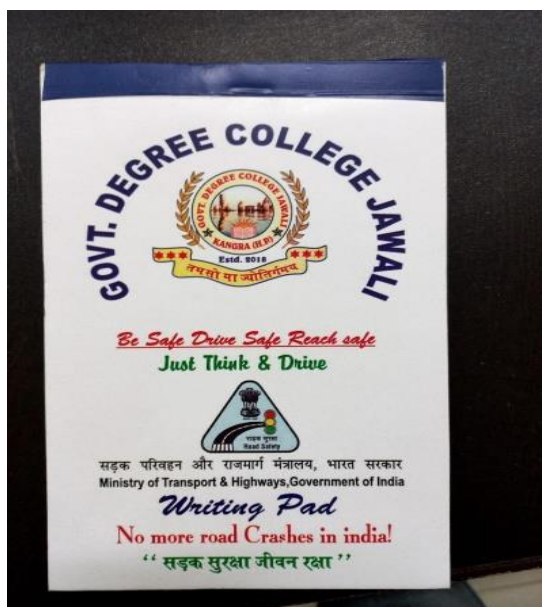
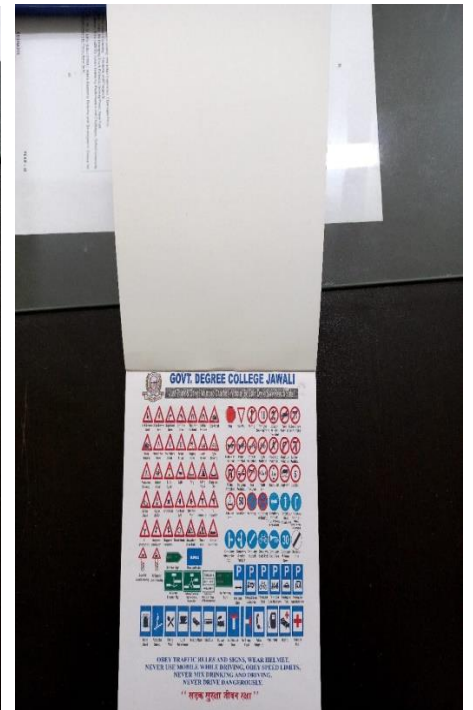
