SESSION 2023-24

The Road Safety Club plays a crucial role in promoting road safety awareness and education in local communities. With a mission to reduce the number of accidents and fatalities on the roads, the club organizes various events on the importance of safe road practices. Through its programs, the club also aims to raise awareness about the consequences of reckless driving and the need for stricter road safety regulations. The Road Safety Club is committed to promoting safe and responsible driving practices and reducing the number of road accidents. Over the past years, we have continued to work to achieve this goal. Road Safety Club has also been working to raise awareness about the importance of following traffic rules and regulations.

During the session 2023-24, enrolment as a volunteer started in the month of August 2023, and Road Safety Club received 56 applications from various courses. Three road safety volunteers from the previous session appointed as group leaders for 2023-24, tasked with guiding and mentoring students on road safety principles and practices. To achieve the above stated goal, classes were undertaken, organised awareness rally, a guest lecture on the "Importance of Road Safety" was organised, and various competitions were organised such as essay writing, slogan writing, and quiz competition. Distribution of printed materials such as Road Safety Diaries was also undertaken.

ACTIVITIES

ROAD SAFETY INDUCTION PROGRAMME

The Road Safety Induction Programme held on 04-09-2023 aimed to inform and engage newly enrolled road safety volunteers regarding the mission and objectives of the Road Safety Club. Additionally, the event provided a platform to discuss forthcoming activities and strategies to promote road safety awareness within the college community.

The induction programme commenced with an opening address by Mr. Nishant Narang, who outlined the core objectives and vision of the Road Safety Club. He emphasized the importance of road safety awareness and the pivotal role volunteers play in achieving this objective. He highlighted the alarming statistics related to road accidents and reiterated the need for proactive measures to mitigate these risks. Dr. Dinesh Kumar Sharma, the Principal, shared his insights on the significance of student involvement in community initiatives such as road safety awareness campaigns. He stressed the pivotal role educational institutions play in shaping responsible citizens and encouraged volunteers to spearhead efforts in promoting road safety within and beyond the campus.

The Road Safety Induction Programme served as an effective platform to orient newly enrolled volunteers towards the objectives of the Road Safety Club. The motivational addresses by Dr. Dinesh Kumar Sharma inspired volunteers to actively participate in upcoming activities and to zealously spread awareness about road safety among their peers. 






ROAD SAFETY CLASSES

Road Safety Classes were conducted to equip volunteers with essential knowledge and resources to champion road safety. These classes served as invaluable platforms for introducing volunteers to key tools, regulations, and practices aimed at fostering safer roads for all.

Topics covered

<u>Introduction to M-Parivahan App:</u> Volunteers were familiarized with the m-Parivahan mobile application, which serves as a comprehensive platform for accessing various transport-related services. They learned how to utilize the app for tasks such as vehicle registration, e-challan payments, and braining digital documents, thereby promoting efficiency and compliance on the road.

Application Process for Learning Licence: A detailed walkthrough of the process for obtaining a learning licence was provided to volunteers. From filling out application forms to scheduling learner's licence tests, participants gained insights into the procedural requirements and necessary documentation for acquiring this essential credential, laying the foundation for responsible driving practices.

<u>Introduction to MoRTH Website:</u> Volunteers were introduced to the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) website, a valuable repository of information on road safety regulations, policies, and initiatives. They learned how to navigate the website to access resources such as traffic

rules, safety guidelines, and updates on road infrastructure developments, empowering them to stay informed and proactive in promoting road safety.

<u>Importance of Golder Hour:</u> The critical concept of "Golden Hours" in emergency response was discussed, emphasizing the crucial window of time immediately following a road accident. Volunteers learned about the significance of prompt medical intervention during this period and the role they can play as first responders in administering timely aid, potentially saving lives in critical situations.

Raising awareness through Road Safety Videos: In our road safety campaign, we utilized impactful videos to sensitize students to the consequences of reckless driving, speeding, distractions, and drunk driving. These realistic portrayals underscored the vulnerability of pedestrians and emphasized responsible behaviors. By showcasing positive examples and highlighting the risks involved, we aimed to inspire behavioral change and foster a culture of safety. Covering a diverse range of topics, the videos prompted reflection and empowered students to advocate for road safety. Through visual storytelling, we sought to instill a lasting commitment to responsible road practices, contributing to safer roads for all.

<u>Prescribed Road Safety Topics:</u> Additionally, various prescribed road safety topics were covered in the classes, addressing key areas such as defensive driving techniques, pedestrian safety measures, the dangers of drunk driving, and the importance of wearing seat belts and helmets. These discussions provided volunteers with a comprehensive understanding of road safety principles and best practices to uphold on the streets.

















QUIZ COMPEITION

The Road Safety Quiz Competition was organized on 28-12-2023 with the aim of enhancing awareness about road safety. A total of 15 volunteers, divided into 5 teams, enthusiastically participated in the event. The competition fostered a spirit of learning among the participants while reinforcing key principles of road safety.
