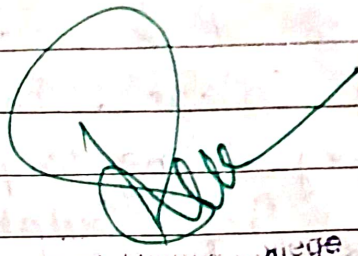


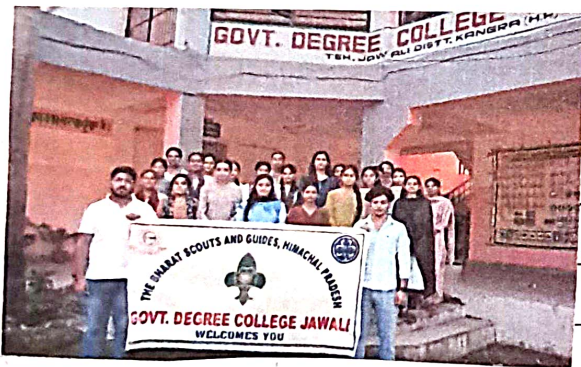
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of freedom, unity, and responsibility towards the nation. He emphasized the role of young citizens, especially the Rovers and Rangers, in nation-building and community service.

3. To promote environmental sustainability through the practice of waste management, recycling, and cleanliness.

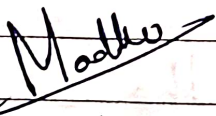

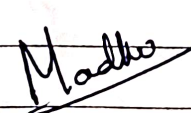
Participants actively engaged in discussions about the values of cleanliness, with values Rovers and Rangers making efforts to raise awareness among other students about the oath and its importance.

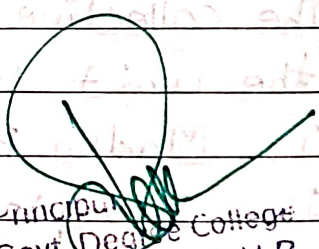
Following the ceremony, the group conducted a cleanliness drive around the campus, actively participating in picking up litter and promoting a clean environment.

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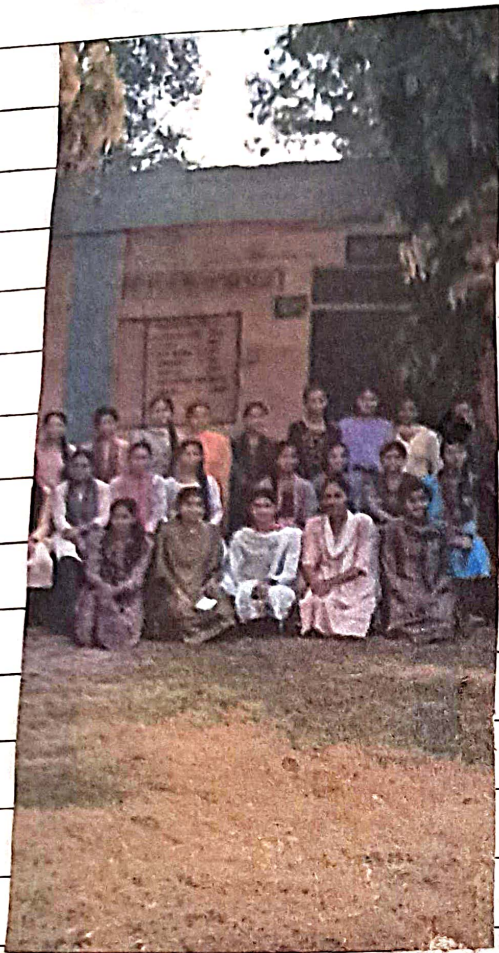

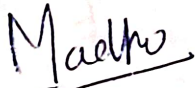

Topic: "Breaking the Silence: Menstrual Hygiene and Awareness Campaign"

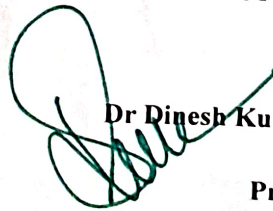
The Rovers and Rangers Unit of Government Degree College Jawali, under the guidance of Dr. Madhu Bala, Assistant Professor in the Department of Commerce, organized a meaningful campaign titled *"Breaking the Silence: Menstrual Hygiene and Awareness Campaign"* on 19th December 2024 to 21st December 2024. The primary objective of the campaign was to educate and create awareness about menstrual hygiene, dispel prevalent myths, and empower young girls and women with essential knowledge about menstrual health. The campaign activities included an enlightening lecture by Dr. Madhu Bala, followed by community outreach efforts conducted by the Rangers, who also utilized posters as an effective medium for awareness.

Dr. Madhu Bala's lecture emphasized understanding the menstrual cycle, maintaining proper hygiene for overall health, and breaking taboos surrounding menstruation. This session encouraged open discussions and aimed to reduce the stigma associated with menstruation. The community outreach segment targeted school-going girls, female residents in villages, and female shopkeepers in local markets. Interactive sessions in schools educated girls about the proper use of sanitary products and the importance of hygiene. In nearby villages, door-to-door campaigns addressed the lack of access to accurate information and resources, while market shopkeepers received practical advice on managing menstruation during work hours. Posters designed and displayed by the Rangers further reinforced key messages and served as visual aids to enhance understanding among diverse groups.

The campaign utilized educational pamphlets, live demonstrations of sanitary product usage, and discussions about eco-friendly alternatives like reusable cloth pads and menstrual cups. Additionally, helpline numbers and local health center details were shared for further assistance. As a result, the campaign significantly increased awareness among participants, who provided positive feedback and expressed appreciation for the initiative. By fostering open dialogue and addressing misconceptions, the campaign successfully empowered participants to take charge of their menstrual health and contributed to building a more informed and supportive community.



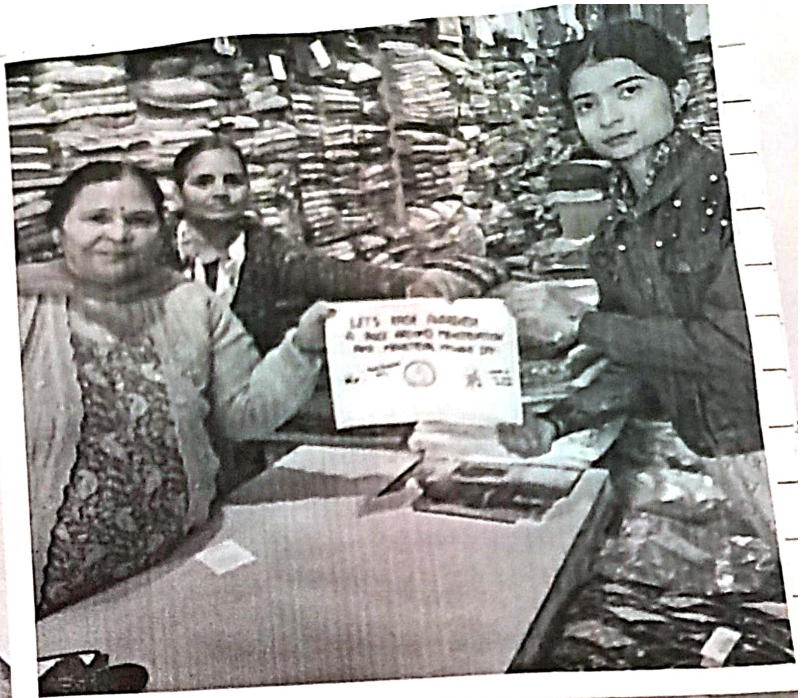
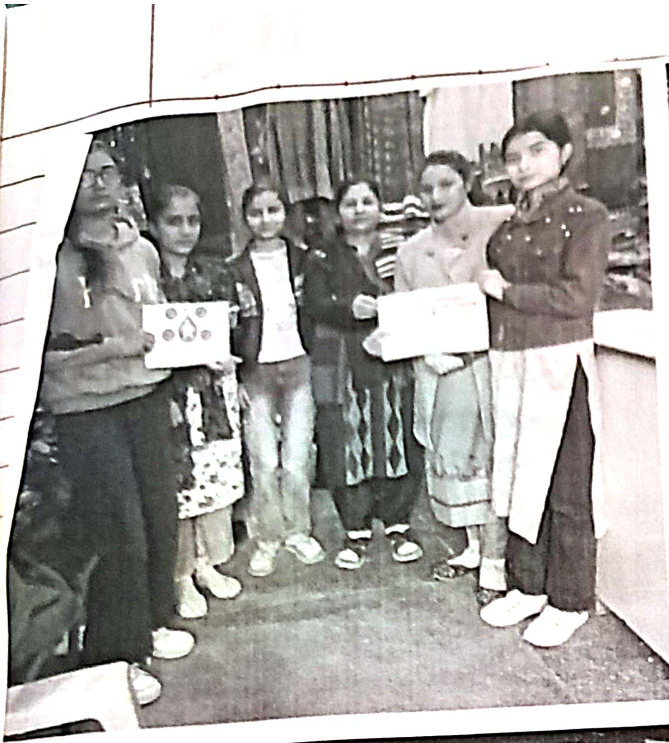
